### LEARNING CENTRE

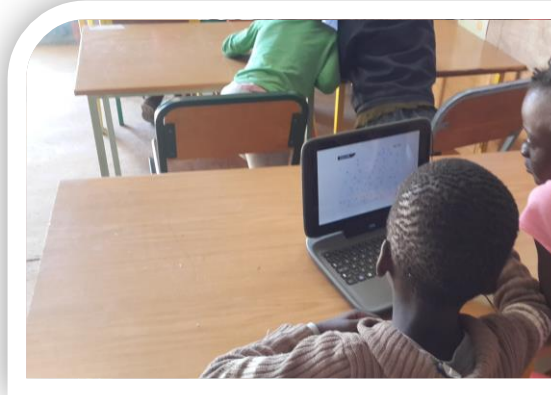
- Sports and exercise encouraged in the morning to let the children release all the adrenalin.
