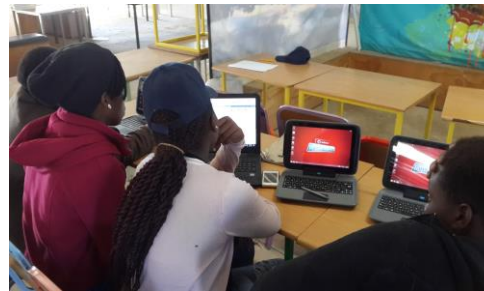
LEARNING CENTRE
